9:45 a. m., WJSV—Some daily programs commence a new time schedule. Hymns of All Churches switches to WJSV at 9:45 a. m. from WRC at 2. Light of the World on WRC is heard at 2 instead of 2:45. Arnold Grimm's Daughter commences at 2:45, half-hour later than usual.

2:15, WRC—The Mystery Man's entrance is one of the results of the above changes. This series will adapt notable detective yarns for serial telling. Mary Roberts Rinehart's "The Window at the White Cat" is the opener.

9:30, WMAL—The Chamber Music Society of Lower Basin Street seems to be going on the air five minutes earlier than its wont, but that also seems to mean it will be off five minutes sooner.
