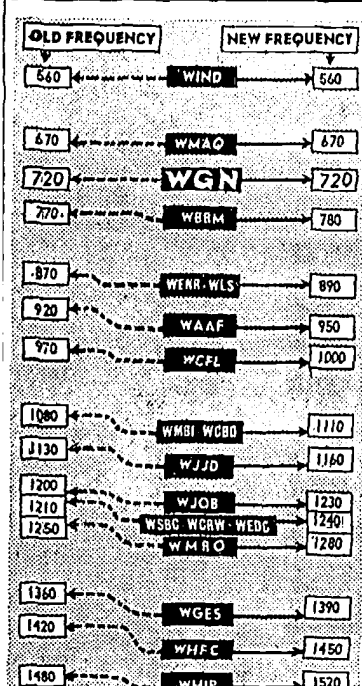

## Radio Changes



The old and new frequencies of Chicago radio stations.

W-G-N continues to broadcast on a frequency of 720 kilocycles today, tho it is moving day for some 802 of the 893 standard broadcasting stations of the United States. W-G-N is one of the 25 clear channel stations in the nation on which 80 per cent of the listeners are said to rely mainly for their programs. Assignment to a clear channel means that no other station is permitted on the same frequency.

The reallocation of broadcasting stations' frequencies is being made under terms of the North American regional broadcasting agreement. The shifts are expected to minimize interference with stations in Cuba, Canada, and Mexico.

The effect on listeners will be that they will find most stations at slightly higher numbers on the dial. Push button sets will require adjustment.
