

# The Post Radio Highlights

10 a. m. WRC—Tallulah Bankhead, who has turned her talents to radio since the close of "Little Foxes," is heard over Lincoln Highway's morning drama.

1:30 p. m., WMAL—Mme. Mero-Irion, founder and director of the Women's National Radio Committee; Eric Roberts, juvenile actor from "Watch on the Rhine," and Dorothy Cocks, beauty expert, are in tow for Ilka Chase's Luncheon at the Waldorf.

3, WJSV—Another chamber music program by the Budapest String Quartet is broadcast from the Library of Congress. Programed are Adagio and Fugue in C minor, Mozart, and Quartet in A minor, Beethoven.

3:15 and 5, WRC, 4:30 WJSV, and 5:15, WOL—Three major networks are covering the Penn Relays, first and most important outdoor track meet of the year. Intermittant broadcasts will bring two and a half hours of reporting on the events at Franklin Field, Philadelphia, for sports fans.

8:30, WJSV—What, again? Yes, for the second time today, Tallulah Bankhead lends her husky voice to the networks. This time it is as the guest at Duffy's Tavern that La Bankhead comes to the mike.

9:30, WMAL—NBC's Summer Symphony period gets under way tonight, with the orchestra under the direction of Reginald Stewart, noted Canadian pianist-conductor. On the bill are the overture to the comic opera Donna Diana, by Reznicek; Brahms's Symphony No. 1, and "Triana" and "Fete Dieu a Seville," from the Iberia Suite by Albeniz.
