The National Folk Festival's opening tomorrow in Constitution Hall is presaged by three special programs from WINX. At 1:15 p. m., Miss Sarah Gertrude Knott, director of the festival, will introduce a group of students of Gordon Junior High School in American folk songs. In the evening from 7:30 to 8 will come an airing direct from the Hall of the arrival and rehearsals of the groups. Again at 9:20, WINX will open its mike for more on the spot preliminaries of the three-day fete.

9, WMAL—Vice President Wallace, Edward J. Flynn and James A. Farley are the speakers at the Twenty-sixth Anniversary Dinner of the New York Young Democratic Club. Thomas Boyle is chairman.

9:30, WJSV, WRC, WMAL and WOL—President Roosevelt, Secretary of the Treasury Morgenthau and Postmaster General Frank Walker address the Nation on the eve of the campaign to sell defense stamps and bonds. Secretary Morgenthau opens the half-hour, is followed by the Postmaster General speaking from Des Moines and finally by the President, talking from the White House.
