W-G-N's football broadcast for today will be a play-by-play account of the Northwestern-Illinois game. Originating from Dyche stadium in Evanston, the game will be reported by Bob Eison starting at 1:15 p. m. A highlight of the broadcast will be presented at halftime when three of Northwestern's stars—Ike Kepford, George Benson, and Buss Heagy—will be inducted into the United States naval aviation cadets corps. They will be sworn in by Capt. W. F. Amsden, director of the United States naval reserve for the 9th naval district. Kenneth L. [Tug] Wilson, athletic director of Northwestern, will act as master of ceremonies.

A description of the launching of the U. S. S. Indiana, newest battleship, will be aired over W-G-N at 11 a. m. The program will be presented from Newport News, Va.

Radio's Voice, the interview show presented by Guy Savage from the outer lobby of the Chicago theater, is scheduled at noon. Guy also will be heard on the Musical Scoreboard immediately following the football game.
