TODAY'S RADIO HIGHLIGHTS

PRESIDENT TRUMAN'S address before the special session of Congress will be broadcast at 1:30 p. m. over WRC, WTOP, WOL, WMAL, WINX, WINX-FM, WWDC and WWDC-FM.

A series called "You and the Russians" begins tonight at 11:15 over WTOP-CBS and will be continued nightly through Friday of this week. Lyman Bryson, CBS counselor on public affairs, will interview experts on Russian culture, strategy and aspirations. Ernest J. Simmons, professor of Russian language and literature at Columbia, will speak tonight.

"Congress Today," a series of weekday comments on Capitol Hill news, begins tonight at 6 over WOL with Newsroom Chief

Al Warner broadcasting. The 10-minute programs are followed by five minutes of local news.
