TODAY'S RADIO HIGHLIGHTS

"THE House That Jack Built," a disc jockey show featuring Harold Jackson, makes its WINX debut tonight at 11:30. Jackson was on WOOK at one time with the same show. On WINX, it'll be a nightly affair, Monday through Saturday, lasting until 12:55 a. m.

Duke Ellington, composer, pianist and orchestra leader, will make his disc jockey debut tonight on a number of stations throughout the country. Locally it is WWDC which will broadcast the show from midnight until 1 a. m..

Records will be supplied locally; the Duke's comments will be taken from transcriptions mailed to the station. (This neat

trick enables Ellington to make as many of these transcriptions as he pleases without running afoul of the Petrillo ban on recorded music, since he will be recording nothing but the verbal fill-ins.)
