The American soldier is seeing more of Japan today than any tourist in peacetime. GI's travel free on Japanese trains and they are busy going on private excursions on Army-conducted tours in and around the major cities of Tokyo, Yokohama, Osaka and Kyoto and many shrines, parks, lakes, and other points of interest throughout the islands.
