SIXTY YEARS AGO

IN THE TIMES, JAN. 25, 1890:
After an investigation covering many months, 23 culprits were arrested, charged with looting railroad passengers' trunks and baggage on trains between this city and New York. Many baggagemen and messengers were involved and the entire loss was estimated at \$200,000.

WASHINGTON—The Senate Committee on Naval Affairs decided upon a policy to build up the U.S. Navy to great strength by the rapid construction of heavy line-of-battle ships on the lines of the royal navy's monster, HMS Benbow.

THIRTY-FIVE YEARS AGO

IN THE TIMES, JAN. 25, 1915:
WASHINGTON—President Wilson declared the American right to ship goods, war material or otherwise, anywhere on the high seas. The policy was outlined in a letter to Sen. Stone.

BERLIN—German Imperial Chancellor Von Bethmann-Hollweg defended his notorious description of the Belgian neutrality treaty as "a scrap of paper." He said he was astonished at the reaction in the United States and said Ameri-

cans had taken the wrong view. The British, he said, were responsible for the invasion of Belgium.

LONDON—A British fleet intercepted a squadron of German battle cruisers attempting to repeat their raid on the English coast. The armored cruiser Bluecher was sunk and two battle cruisers damaged. The British opened fire on the Germans at a distance of more than 10 miles.

FIFTEEN YEARS AGO

IN THE TIMES, JAN. 25, 1935:
The grand jury reported that "millions" had been wasted on attempts to build a dam in San Gabriel Canyon. The jury attributed the waste to the influence of politics.

WASHINGTON—The House passed the \$4,880,000,000 "jobs-for-all" bill, 328 to 78.

NEW YORK—The steamer Mohawk was in collision with the Norwegian freighter Talisman five miles off Sea Girt, N.J. The Mohawk's passengers and crew were removed just before she rolled over and sank.

FLEMINGTON, N.J.—Bruno Hauptmann testified in his trial for the Lindbergh kidnaping that he was at home on the night the man "John" obtained the ransom of \$50,000.
