SIXTY YEARS AGO
IN THE TIMES, JUNE 11, 1890:

WASHINGTON—Bids were opened for the largest ship ever designed for the U.S. Navy, an armored cruiser of 8100 tons. The Union Iron Works of San Francisco was apparently low bidder at \$3,100,000.

LONDON—The Standard denounced Secretary of State Blaine for sending cruisers to the Bering Sea. Force, it said, could lead only to force.

PARIS—The French Minister of Foreign Affairs announced a note had been sent to London, suggesting the evacuation of Egypt by British forces.

THIRTY-FIVE YEARS AGO
IN THE TIMES, JUNE 11, 1915:

WASHINGTON—The note to Germany regarding sinking of the Lusitania and other vessels was made public. As forecast, it demanded that effective measures be taken to safeguard American ships and American lives at sea. The alternative to a refusal was not stated. The note was signed by Robert Lansing as Secretary of State ad interim.

FIFTEEN YEARS AGO
IN THE TIMES, JUNE 11, 1935:

SACRAMENTO — The Leg-

islative Conference Committee adopted an income tax bill, with rates one-fourth those of the Federal.

NEW YORK—The estate of the late Benjamin M. Duke, tobacco magnate, was appraised at \$7,496,447.

SASSARI, SARDINIA—Premier Mussolini declared Italy had abundant raw materials for war purposes, without importation, Sardinia, he said, had both coal and iron.
