

Murrow's Latest: 'Educated Woman'

Edward R. Murrow's last radio report, "The Business of Sex," a study of call-girl racketeers in American business, created a small furor throughout the country and was received with sharp and violent criticism from certain areas of industry.

Nearly every time Murrow loses one of his CBS specials, quite a rumble follows. Ed has touched on the segregation issue, the call-girl thing and many other controversial matters.

At least Murrow, unlike other reporters in radio, has the fortitude to disturb the medium's stagnant atmosphere and to provide some indication that radio is still alive.

This all leads up to the latest Murrow effort, "The Educated Woman," which airs Saturday over KNX at 9:05 p.m. Perhaps this broadcast may not create a nation-wide upheaval, but, nevertheless, it should be stimulating.

"The Educated Woman" is a report on higher education for women, its aims and achievements, its successes and failures and the deep-seated differences in educational philosophies.

Educators to Speak

The program will present, in their own voices, the views and experiences of noted educators, alumnae and their families, sociologists, employers and others.

Among the list of educators are Jerome Ellison, member of the faculty at Indiana University and author of the recent controversial magazine article, "Are We Turning Our Colleges Into Playgrounds?"; Eunice Roberts, dean of faculties at Indiana University, and Dr. Mirror Komarovskiy of Barnard College, sociologist and author of "Women in the Modern World."

Irving Gittin, director of the public affairs department of CBS news, in announcing the program, said:

"In this age where women are assuming a constantly increasing responsibility in the professions and in public life, in addition to their traditional role of wife and mother, this program is designed to examine whether or not our institutions of higher learning are preparing their students properly to face the challenge of the critical years ahead."
