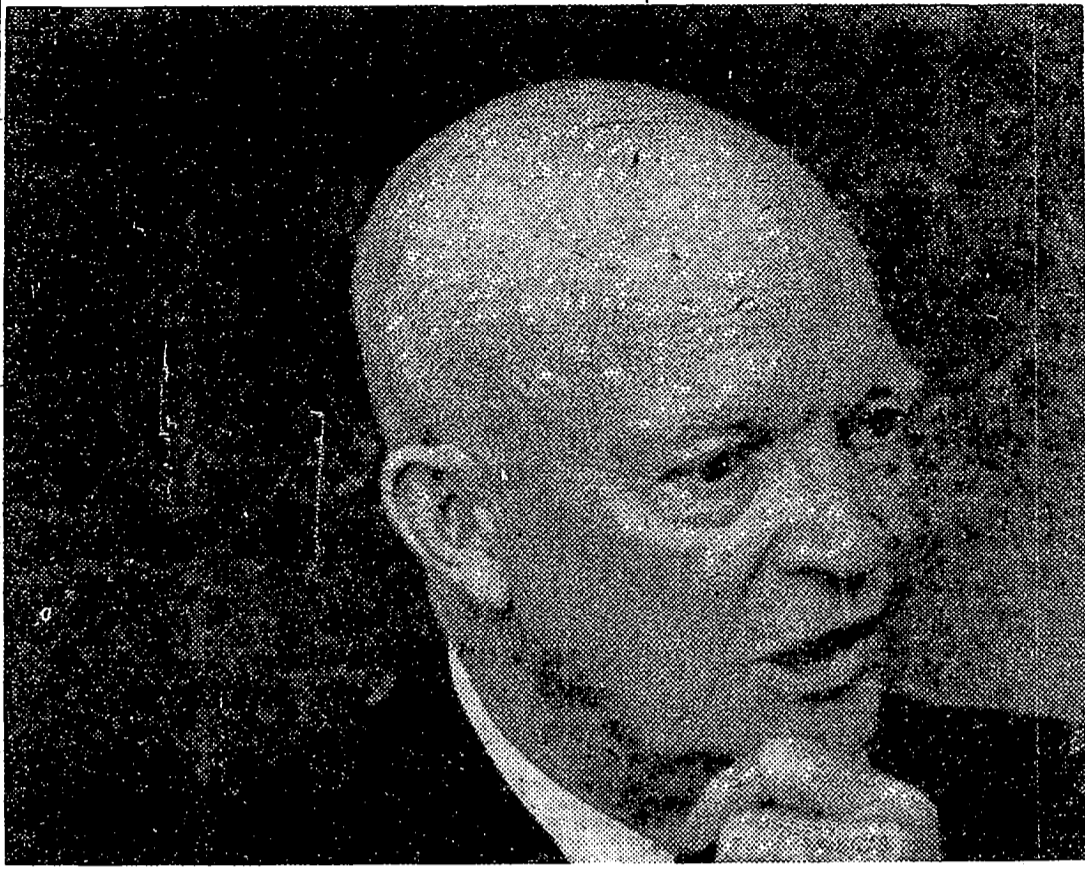


A CBS NEWS EXTRA!

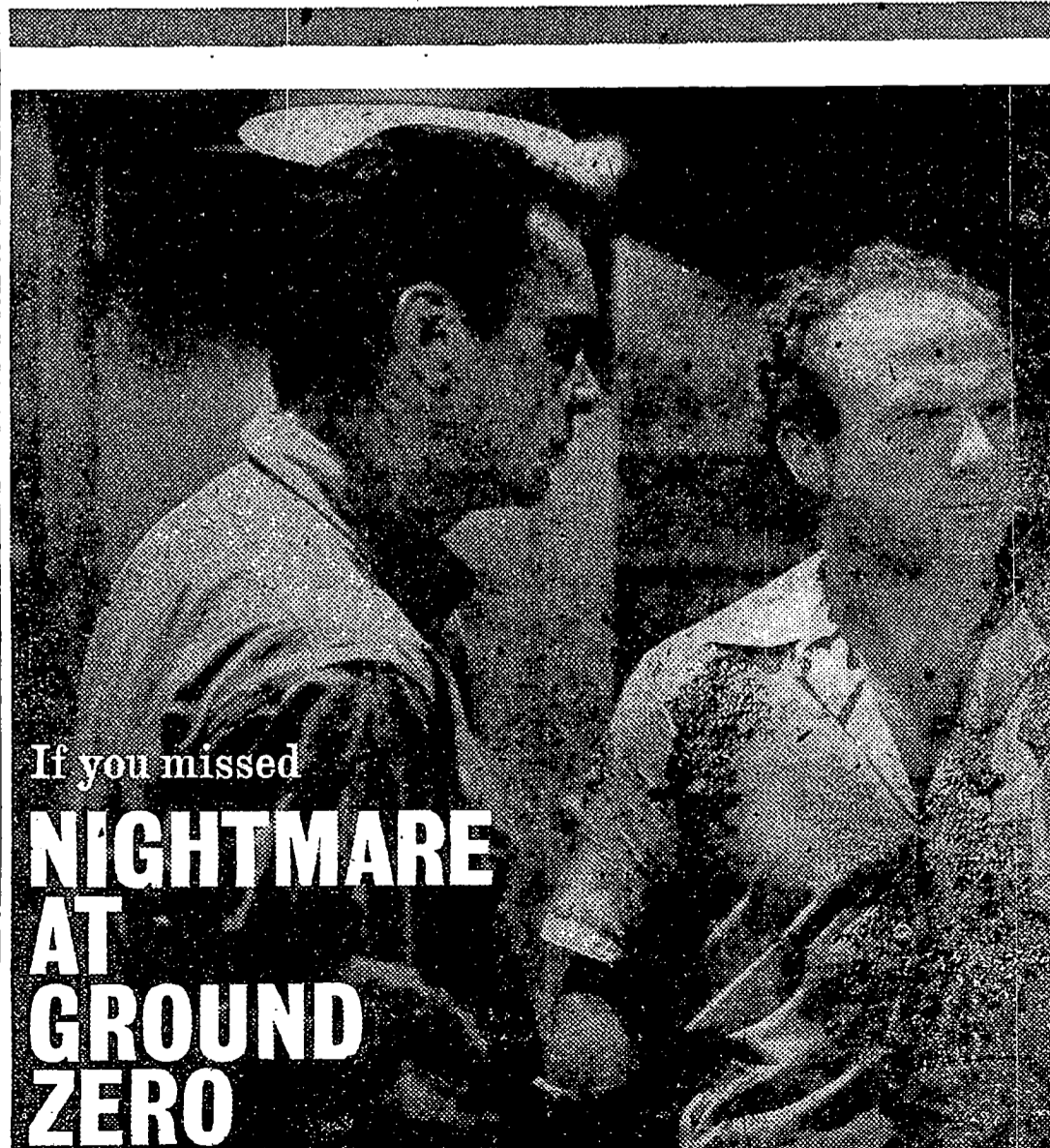


EISENHOWER IN BONN
