The W-G-N Mutual coronation broadcast schedule for today follows [all time is Chicago daylight saving time]:
4:00 a. m.—W-G-N opens program.
4:30 a. m.—King and queen leave Buckingham palace for Westminster abbey.
5:00 a. m.—Coronation service in the abbey, lasting about two hours.
7:40 a. m.—King and queen leave Westminster for return procession to palace.
9:10 a. m.—Royal couple reaches Buckingham palace.
12:45 p. m.—Loyalist salute.
1:00 p. m.—Royal salute of 21 guns.
1:10 p. m.—Address by the governor general of Canada.
1:20 p. m.—Empire homage service in which Prime Minister Baldwin and other premiers of empire answer radio roll call.
2:00 p. m.—King George addresses the empire.
