"The New South," the address given by Editor Henry W. Grady which contributed greatly in the work of reuniting the north and south, will be broadcast on the Gems of American Eloquence over W-G-N at 10 p. m. Forest Lewis will enact the rôle of Grady. A dramatic cast will present a picture of the circumstances leading up to the oratorical event.

At 9:30 p. m. the Friday Promenade, a program of light and semi-classical music directed by Henry Weber, will offer the singing of Kathryn Witwer and Wesley Summerfield with music by the W-G-N concert orchestra. Miss Witwer will sing Arditi's "Il Bacio" and will join Summerfield in "A Brown Bird Singing." Summerfield also will sing "For You Alone." The orchestra will offer themes from Franz Lehar's Count of Luxembourg; Stringfield's "Cripple Creek"; "Indian Love Call," from Friml's Rose Marie, and Rubenstein's "Melody in F." The two programs, Friday Promenade and Gems of American Eloquence, will be presented before 600 guests in W-G-N's main audience studio.

"Save the Middle Class" is the subject of an address to be given on W-G-N by former Congressman Samuel Pettengill of Indiana at 11 o'clock tonight.
