The notification ceremonies and acceptance address of Wendell Willkie will be broadcast by W-G-N—Mutual today. W-G-N will be on the air from Elwood from 2:30 p. m. to approximately 5:10 p. m.

From 2:30 to 3 p. m. at Callaway Park, Quin Ryan will present Mrs. Edward B. Hall, chairman of the women's executive committee of the women's division of the Cook County Republican Central committee; John T. Dempsey, chairman of the Cook County committee; Adelaide Sabs, president of the office girls' club which has saved nickles to help the Willkie campaign, and "Miss Columbia", who is to ride Mini, the G. O. P. Elephant.

Approximately 3 o'clock ceremonies at the Elwood High school with Willkie greeting old friends and acquaintances will be aired. Then will follow a description of the procession to Callaway park.

The notification ceremonies, starting at 4, will open with an invocation by Dr. William Lowe Bryan. Then Chairman Arch Bobbit of the Indiana Republican committee will introduce Congressman Charles Halleck of Indiana, who in turn will present Congressman Joseph P. Martin Jr., chairman of the Republican National committee, who will notify Mr. Willkie. The acceptance address follows.
