\$5 PRIZE RECIPE

Orange Torte
(Eight servings)

4 egg whites
1/4 teaspoon cream tartar
1/4 teaspoon salt
3/4 cup sugar

Filling:
4 egg yolks, well beaten
1/3 cup sugar
1 teaspoon grated lemon rind
1 teaspoon grated orange rind
2 tablespoons orange juice
1 tablespoon lemon juice

Topping:
1/2 cup grated semi-sweet chocolate
1 cup cream, whipped

Beat egg whites until frothy. Add cream tartar and salt; beat until stiff. Gradually add sugar. 2 tablespoons at a time, beating thoroughly after each addition. Spread in a well greased and floured 9-inch pie pan, making edges slightly higher than center. Bake in a very slow oven, (275 degrees) 1 hour. Cool. Combine ingredients for filling and cook in a double boiler, stirring constantly until thick. Cool. Sprinkle half of chocolate over meringue. Cover with half of whipped cream, then with orange filling. Top with remaining cream and sprinkle with chocolate. Chill for several hours.
