

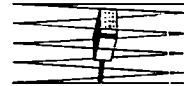
TODAY'S TV Previews

Today's best television shows as previewed by TV Key's staff of experts in New York and Hollywood:

Be a Famous Figure, noon, channel 5—This one hour musical fashion show is pleasant entertainment. They've added a commonplace script and a B movie type score, but the star is the fashion preview and that's worth the attention of every lady. Since Performers Bill Tabbert, Doretta Morrow, Tony Randall, and Jinx Falkenberg are assisted by scores of gorgeous models, the men may be interested, too.

The Buccaneers, 6:30 p. m., channel 2—"Blackbeard." A good opening for this new series of swash-bucklers; thanks largely to a British actor, Alec Clunes. As an ex-pirate arriving in Nassau in the Bahamas with a king's pardon for all buccaneers, Clunes is a dashing, colorful hero. Peter Hammond contributes as a panty-waist navy man; with George Margo in thick makeup as the scurrilous Blackbeard. "Talky" in spots, but above par.

Perry Como Show, 7 p. m., channel 5—Perry opens with a page from Elvis's book, the rock 'n' roller, "Hound Dog." Then into a far more relaxing tune, "September Song," and some old movies screened for the benefit of Tab Hunter and Natalie Wood. Tab's got a "cool" surprise for his fans, but we're sworn to secrecy. Martha Davis and spouse, a big gal and a tiny guy, are great fun to watch. And Como's final medley, including as it does "The Nearness of You," "Almost Like Being in Love," and "Cecelia," makes for pleasant listening.
