Friday's top television shows as previewed and selected by TV Key's staff in New York City and Hollywood:

Your Hit Parade—6:30 p.m.—channel 2—Mel Torme inspires Johnny Desmond and Dorothy Collins to play musical instruments. You'll enjoy Dorothy's attempt to pluck at harp strings while Mel and Johnny sing "Zing Went the Strings of My Heart." Desmond does a clarinet solo to "Johnny One Note," and takes it literally! Peter Genaro's dance with Lisa D'Orso adds color to the show.

Walt Disney Presents—7 p.m.—7—"The Adventures of Chip 'n' Dale." A treat for cartoon fans. This entertaining collection of five cartoons stars those two amusing chipmunks from the Disney drawing table, Chip and Dale. With the exception of the first one, which is rather lightweight, the program is a delight.

Phil Silvers—8 p.m.—2—"Bilko's Sharpshooter." A riot of an episode, especially the first half. Bilko's platoon is doing target duty when they discover that a new recruit has hit 10 out of 10 bull's eyes. Bilko, for betting purposes, gets the sharpshooter assigned to his platoon. Naturally, he gets the wrong man. Leo Leiberman steals the show as a "Sad Sack," and Peggy Cass gives her customary competent performance as the real sharpshooter.

M Squad—8 p.m.—5—"The Take-Over." The extortion-protection racket again, but this time there's an old fashioned gang war on to see which mob is going to run Chicago. If you can't figure it out for yourself, it's Lee Marvin's "gang" that does the running.

Lineup—9 p.m.—2—"The Pigeon Drop Case." A good title and a good show about a confidence game. A salesman who has been played for a sucker in a well handled scheme, decides to go all-out for revenge.
