## ARGUMENT DUE TODAY ON PLEA OF HARVEYS

Arguments on a writ of habeas corpus to obtain the release of William E. Harvey and Lillian B. Harvey, accused of murdering Roy F. Gottschall on the 1st inst., will be heard in Superior Judge Wood's court today. The indictment against the two defendants asserts that they went to Gottschall's home to remove furniture claimed by the woman and that when Gottschall interfered by firing several shots at Harvey the latter struck him over the head with a piece of gas pipe, inflicting injuries which caused his death.
