Perhaps the most outstanding song recital on the evening's entertainment brings Lucrezia Bori, famous Metropolitan Opera soprano to you over KHJ at 4:30. Miss Bori's repertoire will include "Gavotte" from "Manon;" La Violetera (Goetz-Padilla;) Alge della La Cula (Fillipi;) Crying of the Water (Campbell-Tipton;) Kiss in the Dark (Herbert.) and Mirame Asi (De Fuente tango.) Wilfred Pelletier, youngest of Metropolitan conductors, and his thirty-two-piece symphony will feature Tschalkowsky's "Sleeping Beauty Waltz."

Another excellent concert should be that of N.B.C.'s Stromberg-Carlson Hour--The Rochester Civic Orchestra in thirty minutes of the works of Russia's most dazzling orchestral composer. Tschalkowsky, opens with the toy march from the "Nutcracker Suite," and closes with the Overture of 1812. KFI at 6 p.m.

For plays? KECA's Empire Builders with a mystery play--"Missing"--another excellent French Miniatre (KFWB at 9)--this episode titled "Thunder From the Clouds"--while those who want to shadow Sherlock Holmes--His Adventures over KFI at 8 p.m.

And then the laugh hit of the evening--KFRC's Blue Monday Jamboree--through KHJ from 8 to 10 tonight.
