Opera will be broadcast across the Atlantic for the first time today from 1:20 to 2:20 p.m., over KHJ, when the first four scenes in the second act of "The Magic Flute" will be heard from the Royal Operahouse, Covent Garden, London, on the Don Lee-Columbia network.

The opera series at Covent Garden coincides with the height of the London social season.

Noted operatic singers of Britain, continental Europe and the United States are engaged for the season. The cast for the scenes from Mozart's masterpiece consist of Noel Eadie, as Queen of the Night; Marcel Wittrisch, Tamino; Margareta Teschemacher, Pamina; Ivar Andresen of the New York Metropolitan, Sarastro; Herbert Janssen, Orator; Gerhardt Huesch, Papageno; Sofie Schoenning, Papagena. Bruno Walter will conduct.
