Vatican City Address to Be on Both National Chains

Pope Will Give Labor Talk in Three Languages

Program From Siam Capital Slated for Rebroadcast

Two notable broadcasts from points thousands of miles apart in foreign lands will be given to the United States today. They overlap in point of time, yet listeners in may hear parts of both. Pope Pius XI is to speak over the Columbia and National broadcasting systems from Vatican City, Italy, while from far-off Siam the National Broadcasting Company will attempt to rebroadcast a musical program from the capital city of Bangkok.

Both KHJ and KFI will offer the Vatican City program, KHJ starting at 8:30 a.m. while KFI is to bring the first ceremonies at 8 o'clock sharp. His Holiness will speak in three languages, Italian, French and German before 10,000 labor representatives man, when he delivers his address celebrating the fortieth anniversary of the Rerum Novarum Encyclical of Pope Leo XIII. Equally conversant with all, he plans to talk ten minutes in each tongue. An English translation will follow his address in Italian at 9 a.m.

At 9 o'clock the first attempt to rebroadcast a program from Siam is scheduled via KECA. It will be a brief period of fifteen minutes and details of the program are not disclosed. Thus listeners will have the opportunity to switch from Vatican City to Bangkok.
