Three major sports events hold the spotlight in today's radio. Heading the list is the Kentucky Derby at Churchill Downs. Then there are the city high schools track meet and the California intercollegiate track meet, both with Bill Henry at the microphone.

At 1 o'clock "Bill" will face a battery of "nikes" at the Coliseum and for two hours broadcast "the step-by-step" contest of the high school youngsters. Then at 3 the athletes from the University of California, Stanford, University of Southern California and the University of California at Los Angeles will don their athletic B.V.D.s and take over the track for two hours. Both track broadcasts are on KHJ's schedule.

You may desert the boys for a while to tune in on KECA at 2:45 for the Kentucky Derby. Earl Sande, one of the greatest jockeys in turf history, will swap his silks and saddle for a microphone. Clem McCarthy and Graham McNamee are to assist Sande in broadcasting this famous derby. Many of the notables in the colorful crowd, as well as the club officials, the winning jockey and owner, will be invited to speak.
