For the concertgoer, why not the Rochester Civic Orchestra, an N.B.C. feature, KFI at 6 p.m., opening with the stirring "Rakoczy March," the national air of Hungary, and including Saint-Saens's "Gypsy Dance," Dubois's "Fantasy for Trumpet" and Rossini's "Overture to William Tell." A half-hour from New York.

Hitting the high spots here and there, James J. Jeffries, ex-heavy-weight champion of the world, comes out of the past to say a few words to sports lovers on The Times World-wide News broadcast at 12:30 p.m. over KHJ.
