An array of concerts, plays and variety periods of equal merit will be presented by radio today.

Reaching blindly for a few high spots we find the following group to offer:

The regular Thursday evening Standard Symphony Orchestra offering over KFI at 7:30 o'clock, with Mishel Plastro conducting, will have as its opening number Brahms's "Academic Festival Overture," written by the composer over the melodies of old German college songs. Then will follow in an extensive repertoire including the beautiful "Forest Murmurs," from Wagner's "Siegfried," an orchestration of Liszt's immortal "Liebestraum" and the ever-stirring "Beautiful Blue Danube."

Prof. Charles Frederick Lindsley, on the KHJ schedule for 6:30, commands a following with his dramatic readings. Tonight's reading will be H. G. Wells's "Stolen Bacillus."

A half-hour of excellent symphonic music is to be presented by KHJ at 8:30, with Raymond Paige and his Sierra Symphonists, flanked by an ensemble that insures good music and song.

Ruth Etting, whose ability to sing ballads in a heart-touching manner established her as a headliner on Broadway, will be heard over KECA at 4, as the guest-artist with Rudy Vallee and his orchestra.
