Friday on radio finds the evening hours replete with concerts, Alpine troubadours and varieties that will appeal.

The first concert offering, from KHJ at 6 p.m. over Columbia, will present Annette Hanshaw, contralto soloist, in three numbers. They are "Underneath Your Window," "Say a Little Prayer" and "I've Got a Sweet Somebody to Love." Eugene Armandy's Eastern Orchestra with Larry Murphy, tenor, will provide the background.

Switching over to the N.B.C. highlights there are the "Adventures of Kenya Bill" over KFI at 8:30, in which Col. "Simba Bob" is to continue his strange tale of the pit of black magic. A startling discovery is to climax the episode.

An hour earlier—KHJ at 7:30—Frederick Starke is to direct a half-hour concert of all-American music by such composers as Hadley, Gardner, Walter Damrosch, Sousa and Strickland. These Memorial Park Concerts are a standard feature for discriminating music lovers.
