Memorial Day is to be saluted through radio channels by both national networks and local stations.

Before sunrise a broadcast from Japan will be heard over KFI at 4:15 a.m., in which Nippon will join with America in observing the day. United States Ambassador Forbes and Viscount Kentaro Kanoko of the eastern empire, speaking from Tokio, will voice greetings across the Pacific. The program will consist of a five-minute talk by Ambassador Forbes, a ten-minute talk by Viscount Kanoko, and the national music of both east and west.

Soon after the sun floods the Southland KECA and KHJ are to bring President Hoover's address from Valley Forge, Pa., commemorating the famed Pennsylvania bivouac of the Colonial Army. This program at 6:30 this morning will stir the hearts of many throughout the land.

George Bernard Shaw is to be heard over KHJ at 12:20, while in attendance at a dinner in London commemorating the 500th anniversary of the martyrdom of Joan of Arc.

Sports lovers will find Ted Husing describing the track and field events of the fifty-fifth annual Intercollegiate A. A. A. championships at Franklin Field, Philadelphia, on KHJ beginning at 10:30 a.m.

This feature will be interrupted for the Shaw broadcast, and go on the air again at 12:40 noon.

And last but not least, there are the auto races. KFI at 12:15 noon, will offer Graham McNamee reporting the gruelling contest for America's premier racing car honors at the Indianapolis Speedway. It is estimated that the last 100 miles of the 500-mile grind will be reported in the hour allotted for the broadcast.
