Ranging from symphonies to dramatic readings, tonight's radio offerings should prove satisfactory to a large portion of the listening-in public.

By way of contrast it may be mentioned that a former Cabinet member, Helen Morgan, star of the revue stage, and Willie and Eugene Howard, Hebrew comedians, are scheduled in the High Lights.

William Gibbs McAdoo, former Secretary, will be heard over KECA at 8 p.m. during a half-hour broadcast from the Palace Hotel, San Francisco, where he will be guest of honor at a dinner given by the Economic Conservation Committee of America.

Swinging from politics to music, KFI at 7:30 o'clock is to present the Standard Symphony Hour with Michel Plastro, conductor. This hour is dedicated to the Portland Rose Festival and will open with Mayerbeer's Coronation March from "Le Prophete." Particularly appropriate to the atmosphere of the event are two numbers, "Murmuring Zephyrs," by Jensen and "Waltz of the Flowers," from Tschalkowsky's Nutcracker Suite.

Some of the finest of children's music is to be included in the program of the Inglewood Memorial Concert (KHJ at 8:30 o'clock) with Frederick Stark directing his orchestra in a half-hour program. "Baby's Opera," excerpts from "Hansel and Gretel," "Bobby Plays Soldier," "Wooden Shoe Dance," and a host of other fascinating masterpieces for the youngsters will be heard.

And if you'll twist your dial at the conclusion of that concert to KFI, you will be taken to the Shrine Auditorium where the Los Angeles Festival Symphony Orchestra is to play.
