 Saturday is always a highlight on radio with Columbia's "Showboat" churning in with another old-fashioned play—the inauguration of a new series of "pop" concerts from the East and a half-hour with Postmaster-General Brown in a discussion of that branch of the government.

When Hank Simmons's old "Maybelle" sashes up to the levee—KHJ at 6 p.m.—you'll be invited to a three-act drama, "The Poorhouse Brat," or "Fortune Smiled." Described as an old-fashioned comedy with heart-throbbing scenes predominating throughout the play. Jane McGrew will take the star role, that of the Brat, while Hank personally assumes the part of the Man from India.

Concert lovers will greet the inauguration of a new series of Boston Symphony Concerts—KFI at 4:30 p.m. An N.B.C. offering that today not only inaugurates the first "pop" concert but will mark the annual Tech Night, a feature of graduation week at the Massachusetts Institute of Technology. The series, given in Symphony Hall, Boston, will be directed by Arthur Fielder.

KHJ promises to make you love and then to make you laugh. Morton Downey at 7:30 sings "Faithfully Yours," "Nevertheless I Love You" and "Good Night, Sweet Dream," while the Merry-makers rush into the radio lists at 8:15 featuring, as usual, Auntie McKasser, the Three Cheers, Hallelujah Quartet and practically the entire KHJ staff.
