An imaginary trip to the motion-picture studios in Hollywood, the American Derby at Washington Park, Ill., and the third of a series of Boston Symphony popular concerts are three of a kind to add to Columbia's "Show Boat" to make radio worthwhile Saturday night.

First, at 12:15 p.m. over KFI Pacific Feature Hour discovers Rob Wagner, for fifteen years author of Hollywood stories for Collier's and the Saturday Evening Post, known as the man who knows more stars intimately than anyone else in the world, acting as master of ceremonies in three-quarters of an hour with cinema players to include Grant Withers, Sue Carol, Rex Lease, Perry Askam and others.

Then the cream of the country's horseflesh starts in the twenty-third running of the \$50,000 American Derby. KHJ at 1:45 and KECA at 2 p.m. In addition to Twenty Grand, winner of the Kentucky Derby, other three-year-olds to face the barrier for the mile and a quarter race

include Pillburgher. Sweep All and Spanish Play. Clem McCarthy describes it "hoof by hoof."

For concert lovers—why not the third of a series of Boston "pop" concerts—KFI at 4:30 p.m.? A half hour over N.B.C. to include Berlioz's "Hungarian March." Von Weber's "Oberon" overture and Bolzoni's "Minuet." This comes to you direct from Symphony Hall in Boston under the direction of Arthur Fielder.

And for "Drama" why not Columbia's "Show Boat." KHJ at 6, Charlotte Bronte's story of the charity school girl, "Jane Eyre." Be there in the third act—there's a big fire.
