Governor to Speak at New Studio Dedication

Unique Musical Instruments Will Make Debut

Supper will be scarcely on the table at 6 o'clock tonight (KHJ) when the Columbia Broadcasting System sends the address of Gov. Pinchot of Pennsylvania at the dedication of the new studios of Station WHP, Harrisburg, Pa. The musical program will include two compositions arranged by Savino and vocal numbers by the Columbia chorus and sextet.

Musical instruments from one of the most unusual scientific laboratories in the country will be presented (KECA at 5:30). This will be a world premiere for a trio of the ether-wave group of instruments developed by Prof. Therenin. Two of the instruments have never been heard outside the laboratory. Many prominent musicians have hailed the Therenin type as a valuable contribution to music. You know—"the kind you wave your hands over and there's your music."
