Secretary of Commerce Lamont, some of the foremost educators attending the convention of the National Education Association here, the Ryder Cup golf tournament and a gripping story of slave life in Russia will dominate today's radio offerings.

KHJ from 12:45 to 1:30 p.m., and KECA at 3 p.m. offer the finals of the Ryder Cup golf matches from Columbus, O., in which eight American and eight British professionals are competing. Ted Husing will cover the tournament for KHJ.

The National Radio Forum (KHJ at 5:30) brings another Federal executive—Secretary of Commerce Lamont. This is one of a series of addresses by the heads of the national government.

"Slave of Russia" is the title of what Hank Simmons describes "as a gripping story of slave life in Russia in the days when peasants were sold to the highest bidder"—to come drifting in with Columbia's "Showboat"—KHJ at 6 tonight. If you've a tear for melodrama—try it out on this one.

Two prominent educators and a spokesman of the motion-picture industry will be heard at the convention of the National Education Association over KECA at 12:30 p.m. George D. Strayer, professor of educational administration of Columbia University, is to speak on "What the Schools Have Helped America to Achieve." Willis A. Sutton, president of the N.E.A., and Carl Milliken, secretary of Motion Picture Producers and Distributors of America, are the other speakers.
