Overshadowing all other broadcasts on the air today will be the launching of the U.S.S. Constitution, historic frigate, long known as "Old Ironsides."

This will come to you over the Columbia System, KHJ at 11:15 a.m. Through funds contributed throughout the country, "Old Ironsides" has been reconditioned and following its launching will cruise along the eastern seaboard.

Nulton and Cardinal William O'Connor, Archbishop of Boston.
