Proximity of Fourth Incites Radio's Snappy Programs

National and Columbia Bill Unusual Song Recitals

KHJ at 6 p.m. Brings One of Art's Most Costly Concerts

Monday on radio. After the hectic holiday week-end, one usually expects just a lazy beginning of another week, but tonight both the National and the Columbia broadcasting systems bring worthwhile song recitals to you.

KHJ at 6 p.m. floods the air with eight nationally famous motion-picture, stage and radio celebrities—Irene Bordoni, French comedienne; George Jessel, suave master of ceremonies; Helen Kane, the original boopa-doop girl; Walter T. Kelly, famous as the "Virginia Judge;" Belle Baker, ballad queen of vaudeville; John W. Green, Broadway song writer; James Barton, comedian and tap dancer, and Guy Lombardo and his Royal Canadian Orchestra. This is said to be one of the most costly single radio programs ever arranged.

When the clock sweeps around to 6:30 N.B.C. sends through KFI thirty minutes with Cyrena Van Gordon, young American contralto who attained stardom with the Chicago Civic Opera Company. Miss Van Gordon will be presented with Anna Case, former Metropolitan prima donna. In this program the guest artists will sing together in Hawthorne's "Whispering Hope" and Offenbach's "O, Lovely Night," from "The Tales of Hoffman," "Connais-tu le Pays" from "Mignon," by Thomas, has been selected by Miss Case as her solo number, while Miss Van Gordon will sing two solos, "In the Silence of the Night," by Rachmaninoff, and "As We Part," by Ilgenfritz.

And if sopranos drive you mad try "Raspberry Night" by KHJ's Blue Monday Jamboree, 8 to 10 p.m. They say it's going to be one of their best performances—at least you'll have a chuckle or two.
