*Conference on Disarmament
Slated for Discussion*

*Two Symphonies Scheduled,
One at Hollywood Bowl*

The Prime Minister of Great Britain, two ex-Premiers and two symphony offerings of national note occupy the limelight of radio today.

In the early morning hours—KHJ at 6:30 o'clock—Columbia will bring the activities of a mass meeting in Royal Albert Hall, London, the largest of the British capital places of assembly. Three outstanding figures in British politics, Premier MacDonald, leader of the Labor party and head of the government, Stanley Baldwin, Conservative leader and first spokesman of the Parliamentary opposition, and David Lloyd George, war-time Premier and now leader of the Liberal party, are to be the three principal speakers. Under the chairmanship of Field Marshall Sir William Robertson these statesmen will discuss the world disarmament conference proposed in 1932.

The fifth of Tchaikowsky's six symphonies is the work selected for the Lewisohn Stadium concert at the College of the City of New York and to be broadcast over KHJ at 5:30 p.m. with William Van Hoogstraten conducting. The members of this symphony orchestra are drawn from the New York Philharmonic Symphony Society.

Then at 8:30 p.m. listeners-in will be taken for the first time this season to Hollywood Bowl, when a Symphony Under the Stars will be heard over KFI, with Walter Damrosch wielding his baton over an all-Wagner program. Opening with the prelude to Lohengrin—a series of Wagner's most popular works will be presented.
