Talk Abroad Will Be Heard
Throughout America

Tennis Finals Also Listed in
Features for Day

Arlington Classic Another
Broadcast Offering

King George V of England will be heard on eighty-six stations of the Columbia Broadcasting System this morning when he opens the new Ilford Hospital near London. Local release will be over KHJ, the Don Lee station, from 6:40 to 7:15 a.m. This will be the first broadcast by the British monarch at a time convenient to listeners throughout the United States. His two previous international addresses were set for 3 a.m., Pacific standard time, which was a bit too early for many listeners.

The radio day is replete with exceptional offerings. At 10 a.m. KHJ will present the tennis finals from the Longwood Bowl, where two Californians, Johnny Doeg, former Santa Monica boy and son of the former tennis champion, May Sutton Bundy, will play Elsworth Vines of Pasadena.

Both KHJ and KFI are to feature the Arlington classic when the great thoroughbred Twenty Grand, owned by the Whitney stables, faces a marvelous field. KFI takes this at 1 p.m. and KHJ at 1:15 p.m.

Then there is the dedication of WIBA of Madison, Wis., to be released by KFI at 7:30 p.m. Former residents of Wisconsin should not miss this greeting from the old State.

At 8:30 p.m. over KFI will come the "Symphony Under the Stars" from Hollywood Bowl.
