

AUSTRIA TO GIVE RADIO FEATURE

Opera to Be Broadcast From Town of Mozart's Birth

Offering Will Mark Festival in Memory of Composer

Opera will be broadcast from Austria for the first time today from 11 a.m. to 12 noon, Pacific standard time, released locally over KHJ. The occasion is the annual Mozart celebration at Salzburg, Austria.

The performance will be picked up from the stage of the Munich Theater, in the town of Mozart's birth, and with an opera ensemble from Lascala, Milan. The festival was founded by Richard Strauss and Max Reinherdt, along the lines of the Wagner Festival at Bayreuth.

The presentation will be the first part of Rossini's favorite opera, "The Barber of Seville." Music by Mozart or by composers whose lives and works are linked with the prodigy is performed at the Salzburg festival by the leading opera and orchestral interpreters. The Rossini work has been selected for the performance this year because of its association with Mozart's opera, "The Marriage of Figaro." Both are based on the libretto by Beaumarchais, who wrote a series of opera plays, "The Barber of Seville," "The Marriage of Figaro" and "La Mère Coupable."

Though Rossini wrote "The Barber" thirty years after Mozart finished "Figaro," the Italian's work precedes Mozart's in points of action and introduces several of the same characters, particularly Figaro.
