

MILLS SLATED FOR RADIO TALK

Treasury Undersecretary to Be Heard Over KHJ

Negro Chorus of 200 Also Feature of Tonight's Bill

Variety in Other Offerings by Broadcast Stations

Radio this evening runs to variety in its offerings, with playlets, a talk by Ogden L. Mills, undersecretary of the Treasury, and an ensemble of more than 200 trained Negro voices in a concert of spirituals and songs of sorrow of the Ethiopian race.

With the world's attention centered on the moratorium and international financial question the Columbia system,

through KHJ at 6:15 o'clock tonight, is to present Undersecretary Mills. His talk will be of only fifteen minutes' duration, but should be well worth dialing.

After the supper dishes are cleared away and the children put to bed the Associated Negro Chorus will

be heard over KHJ at 9. This group is scheduled to appear at Hollywood Bowl next month and is said to be one of the finest vocal organizations in the Southland. To quote KHJ— "The program is a promise of deep beauty — of something essentially sincere and moving. The curious and immortal Negro melodies of the past 100 years — This is the largest chorus in the West." Part of their repertoire will be found in the High Lights.
