Symphony Presentations Top Schedule for Day

Listeners to Hear Many of Outstanding Classics

A night of beauty is offered by Thursday's radio. There are no international high lights, yet plenty to intrigue your dial in the matter of symphonies and varieties.

Listeners are advised to make note of two offerings. The first is to be over KFI at 7:30 o'clock, when N.B.C. presents Mihal Plastro as conductor of the Standard Symphony Orchestra in an hour embracing the works of Lalo, Brahms, Tchaikovsky and Debussy, and then at 8:30 over KHJ Frederick Stark is to direct the Inglewood Park concert. This feature will provide a half-hour of classical music, opening with Stuart's selections from "Floradora" and closing with a popular hit from "No, No, Nanette."

Scanning the dial for the day, two other programs promise much. The first is to be at 6 p.m. over KHJ, another Lewisohn Stadium Concert. Fritz Reimer, remembered as a guest conductor of the Hollywood Bowl concerts, is to direct the New York Philharmonic Orchestra, and his program will include Liszt's "Mephisto Waltz" and the Strauss tone poem, "Till Eulenspiegel." This is a Columbia special. Pointing your dial to KECA at 6:30 tonight you will find John Charles Thomas, great American baritone. This selections as "Dancing With the Daffodils," "Whispering" and "Making Faces At the Man in the Moon." And so—on to the High Lights.
