Mary Pickford From Here to Talk to Tokio

Nipponese Chorus to Sing in San Francisco

Trans-Pacific Broadcasts to Be Regular Events

 "Hands across the sea" is typified by the launching of a new series of trans-Pacific broadcasts originating at Radio Stations KECA, Los Angeles, and KPO, San Francisco. At exactly 2:15 p.m. the power of radio will speed the voice of Mary Pickford, motion-picture star from Los Angeles to Tokio, Japan.

Japanese radio listeners, seated before their loudspeakers at 7:15 a.m. tomorrow, will hear the program broadcast by N.B.C. from San Francisco and Los Angeles at 2:15 p.m. today.

Arrangements have been made by N.B.C. and the Broadcasting Corporation of Japan to send a half-hour program to Tokio through the Radio Corporation of America's short-wave transmitter at Solinas, with one or more motion-picture stars appearing during the Los Angeles portion of the broadcast and a Japanese chorus and an orchestra participating in the San Francisco presentation. The announcements will be made both in English and Japanese.

And, in turn, a network of Japanese stations will rebroadcast the program in the Orient.

The fact that Mary Pickford was asked to speak on the first broadcast is due entirely to a popular request of the people of Japan.
