 "Down to the sea in ships" slips into radio today as a Columbia broadcast over KHJ at 8 o'clock this morning, when the ships of the air fleet destroy a steel freighter of the United States merchant marine—and with this beginning Tuesday offers plenty of variety.

For instance, there are three plays bidding for your dial, three sporting events, a number of worth-while concerts—and we'll enumerate just a few.

At 2:30 p.m. portions of the transcript of the current Clark murder trial will be read over KNX—attaches of this studio taking the different parts. For another play, why not KHJ at 9:30 o'clock tonight "From The Ground Up"—described as a drama built about aviation; or if you'd rather follow the Adventures of Polly Palmer, a snappy red-headed newspaper reporter, KNX at 9:30 p.m. discovers Polly attending a vice baron's wedding, a plentiful mixture of love and poison naturally enlivening the plot.

In the world of sports, KMTR at 8:30 o'clock switches you to Wrigley Field for the nightly ball game. If baseball fails to hold you, tune in KFWB at 9:30 p.m., where you will find Tod Morgan and Bobby Pachio battling for the California lightweight title and sharing spotlight honors with two promising middleweights, Harry Smith and Harry Goodland.

And for the concert lover, the run of the dial with two particularly promising spots—KHJ at

9 o'clock, when Raymond Paige's orchestra and vocalists go Spanish in honor of the coming fiesta. And KHJ at 6:30 o'clock when Domenico Savino, composer and director of this Columbia program, offers as his closing selection the Finale from Act III of Ponchielli's opera "La Gioconda." Savino also will present several of his own works, including the delightful intermezzo, "Kiki."
