Bryan Fields, turf critic, will eyewitness the horse racing events at Saratoga with Ted Husing today over KHJ. Details of just what events will take place on the track have not been received, but with Husing describing a horse race you'll enjoy it, even if Spark Plug is running.

If you'll spin your dial to KFI at 12:15 noon you are promised the "Highlights of the Southern California of today," including an informal visit with notables of the screen world. R.-K.-O. is to offer some of its best talent. The program should be worth a hearing.
