Three plays, two sporting events, a bouquet of good concerts and what seems to be a final resting place for the Beverly Hill Billies are included in today's radio.

Of the plays, the first is to be given over KFI at 9 o'clock tonight—the thrilling scene as Francis Scott Key glimpsed the American flag still flying as the British guns thundered. This is to be a dramatization of the birth of "The Star Spangled Banner," with a musical background provided by a band under direction of Max Bendix, official bandmaster of the Chicago World's Fair.

You'll have to make a choice between two offerings at 9:30. KHJ is to present Lindsay MacHarrie in a drama of his own entitled "The People vs. Nanello," based on a murder trial in the East some years ago, and with the current major murder trial in Los Angeles in session you may be "murder-minded" for the moment. In the cast will be the author, Bob Swan, Ted Osborne and others. At the same hour KNX is to offer the further adventures of Polly Palmer, news reporter. Polly interviews a motion-picture actor—almost.

The Beverly Hill Billies unquestionably command a large and loyal share of the Southland's listeners-in. After leaving KMPC they tarried for a night with KECA, and today will bob up over KECA at 1.
