You'll have to gasp for breath in selecting your programs today—for from the time the DO-X superplane glides into New York City until radio station KNBC, Kansas City, whoops it up in celebration of its anniversary—you'll have plenty to scan on the dial. And, first and foremost—the boys who made Nelly Bly jealous, Post and Gatty, make a three-point landing in Los Angeles at 12:45 p.m. over KHJ.

At 8:30 this morning Ted Husing climbs aboard the DO-X as it glides into New York—sending over the Columbia Broadcasting System—through KHJ—a word picture of this gigantic plane, a word or two perhaps from its navigator and sidelights of the ceremonies attending its arrival.

## POST AND GATTY

Speeding back to Los Angeles—KHJ at 12:45 tunes in on the Los Angeles Chamber of Commerce

luncheon—said to be one of the most brilliant luncheons of its career—where it will extend welcome to the round-the-world flyers—Post and Gatty. Eddie Cantor will be toastmaster—and, not content with regaling these aviation celebrities with his wit—he will sing two numbers from his new picture.

Besides Post and Gatty and their wives—there will be Admiral Chase of the United States Navy, Col. Miller, in command of the Army on the Pacific Coast, and a host of notables, including Mayor Porter and other city officials.

And then—KECA at 1 p.m. will carry you to Banff, B. C.—in the heart of the Canadian Rockies—where you can participate in the opening of the Highland Gathering and Scottish Musical Festival.

## MUSIC FEATURED

The musical portion of the elaborate program will feature music of Scotland—including, of course, bagpipe numbers. There also will be vocal solos by Robert Burnett, distinguished Scottish baritone; Jeanne Dusseau, talented Canadian soprano, and Theodore Webb, N.B.C. baritone. Ethel Luening, from the American Opera Company, and Amy Fleming, contralto from the Albert Hether Light Opera Company, will also be heard. The program will include the singing of songs of the North by a chorus accompanied by an orchestra under the direction of Leslie Atkins of the Minneapolis Symphony Orchestra.
