KHJ at 1 p.m. offers you a chair at the Blitmore Hotel banquet given by the Metropolitan Water District with speakers bringing a message of vital importance to every Californian. They will include Congressman Crail, Evans and Swing and John Bullock, chairman of the water board.

And if you've a desire for a bit of Bohemian atmosphere, KNX at 11 taps the Paris Inn frolic in a melee of street singing and dance music.
