The Fiesta is twice saluted tonight, the first time at 8 p.m. over KECA and again over KFI at 8:45. Both programs are dedicated to the present festival and should include a gala repertoire of Spanish music and song.

The first will be at 8:15 p.m., when Raymond Paige brings his orchestra to feature Margit Hegedys, noted Hungarian violinist, in a fifteen-minute recital. You will scarcely hear the last of this recital when KHJ cuts into KFRC, the Don Lee San Francisco station, to bring a concert under the direction of Meredith Wilson. They will pay tribute to the forthcoming San Francisco opera season with arias, duets and overtures from "Carmen," "Lohengrin," "Aida" and "The Masked Ball," to be supplemented with the voices of Audrey Farncroft, soprano, and Charles Bulotti, tenor, in solos.
