Radio's Friday fans will find a
feast of entertainment set before
them from the mid-morning hour of
10:30 when the national men's sin-
gles championships command the
air to the broadcast by three radio
stations of the Fiesta's Pageant of
Jewels in the evening.

With Sidney Wood, Ellsworth
Vines and Johnnie Doeg, the de-
fending champion, representing
California, the sporting world of the
West Coast will dial in on Colum-
bia's broadcast through radio sta-
tion KHJ at 10:30 this morning.
Ted Husing will be at the "mike"
as the semifinal matches are being
fought at Forest Hills, and no lover
of tennis tournaments should miss
this one.

Scarcely after supper hour, the
first gun of the description of the
Fiesta's Pageant of Jewels at the
Coliseum is to be fired, when KPWB
at 7 o'clock floods the air with
Stadium entertainment. At 8:30
p.m. the National Broadcasting Sys-
tem through KFI tunes in on the
event, while at 9 p.m. KHJ, of the
Don Lee-Columbia chain, switches
its controls to bring to you pictures
of what is expected to be the high
spot of the Fiesta's entertainment.
