Sometimes it's easy to select the most outstanding programs in a radio day and sometimes it's not. Today it's not, so we'll play kids reaching in a grab bag, and we've pulled out a few national network programs.

First, we've heard a lot about Columbia's Jewish art program coming over KHJ at 1 o'clock this afternoon; it is a half hour of Hebrew music and song. Coming as it does with the Jewish feast days it should prove particularly outstanding.

Just before evening opens with its horde of interesting programs tune in on KHJ again at 4:30 o'clock. "The March of Time" will dramatize six or eight headline news stories. They tell us that it is "one of the really absorbing, informative and different programs. The scenes shift as quickly and dramatically as modern events."

After that I'd tab two other KHJ periods that may prove entertaining, the first at 9:15 o'clock when Chilean independence day is saluted and you will hear a number of local Chilean musicians and singers. Onofre Vidal, operatic tenor who is said to have recently scored a success at La Scala, Milan, will sing "Ya, Ya, Ya," Tito Davison, a Chilean motion-picture star, will be there, too.

And for concert music, this column today seems to be all KHJ; so let's pick Raymond Paige's "Vignettes," the first of a new series in which the life and music of Rimsky-Korsakoff are reviewed.
