Dr. Ray Lyman Wilbur, Secretary of the Interior, will discuss "The Cost of Medical Care," and can be heard over KFI at 9:30 this morning. Dr. Wilbur is chairman of the Committee on the Cost of Medical Care which is making a five-year study on this subject.
