KFAC, in times gone by KTBI, stepped in with the news that first at 6 tonight they'll bring Charley Keppen, to the microphone to tell us all about the Occidental vs. U.C.L.A. football game, then at 7:45 they'll have John Swallow sitting at the mike in the Coliseum telling you just how the game is carried on.

Leaving sports aside, I confess I'd be tempted to dial KHJ's Vignettes at 9:15 tonight. The second episode in the life and music of Rimsky-Korsakow brings the famous Scheherazade Symphonic Suit. In this Korsakow tells in music the story of the Arabian Nights, and, too, they promise novel vocal and dramatic interpolations.

But above all, dial KFWB's Northland, at 8:30 p.m. A cast of twenty principals and fifty extras is the opening announcement, to make a Polar Frolic, one of the biggest and most ambitious entertainments in KFWB's history. We are assured it is the "Beginning of a series of programs of a kind never before attempted on the air." Travel with an explorer into the frozen wastes of the Northland, meet the King of the Norge. If only just a bit of the advance publicity is true, you'll shiver and thrill. If not, it should be fairly good, anyway.
